

TWO SPECTACULAR EXAMPLES OF HIGH-SPEED AND TIME LAPSE PHOTOGRAPHY FROM JPL

High-Speed: The crashing of a 720 commercial aircraft at Edwards Air Force Base in the Southern California desert. One hundred high-speed film and video cameras were employed to cover the crash and the resulting fire. A twenty-second event expanded to a screen time of over ten minutes.

Time Lapse: The building of the Keck Observatory and Telescope atop Mauna Kea on the Big Island of Hawaii, filmed over a seven-year period, reduced to five minutes of screen time.
